Strong Autumn Vigour

SY HARNAS displays excellent autumn vigour which is ideal for later sowings and helping to combat any potential threat from flea beetle attack. Goldcrop trials and indeed DAFM observations year-to-date have also observed strong vigour throughout the growing season.

Good Agronomic Traits

SY HARNAS exhibits favourable agronomic traits, scoring well for lodging and disease resistance. It also comes to flower early providing a long pod-fill period for maximum photosynthesis and yield development.
