A synthetic pyrethroid insecticide for the control of aphids and the reduction of BYDV (barley yellow dwarf virus) in cereals



WARNING: Increased Aphids activity due to the favourable warm conditions that have prevailed recently.

You will probably notice that aphid numbers in cereal crops are on the increase due to the favourable warm conditions that have prevailed recently. Aphids feeding on spring sown crops that are in grain fill stages of development can damage the yield potential, and therefore the numbers present on any crop should be monitored closely.

The guideline thresholds for spraying are ;

Greater than 66% of ears infested with aphids
Greater than 5 aphids per ear
Aphid numbers are increasing

Please note that Sumi-Alpha has full label approval for the control of summer aphids on crops that are eared out, summary information as follows ;

APPROVED CROPS

Barley, Wheat, Oats, Triticale

APPLICATION RATE

200 mls per hectare (winter crops)
165 mls per hectare (spring crops)
NB - Use a min of 200 litres water per hectare, and preferably apply in late evening / early morning time.

LATEST TIMING FOR APPLICATION

GS 73 (early milk stage) on barley and oats
GS 77 (late milk stage) on wheat and triticale

MAX NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS

1 per crop (summer use)
